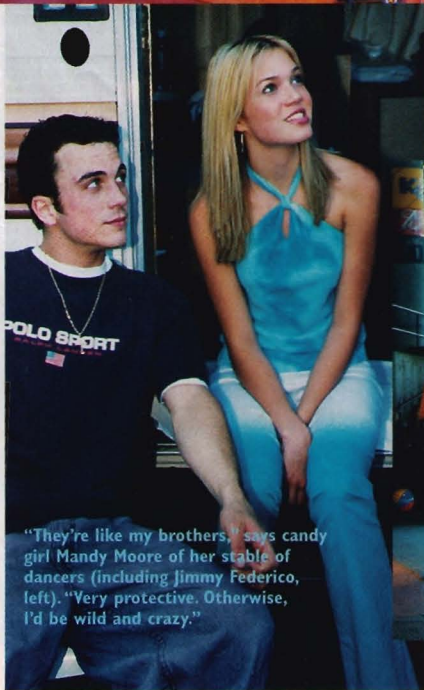

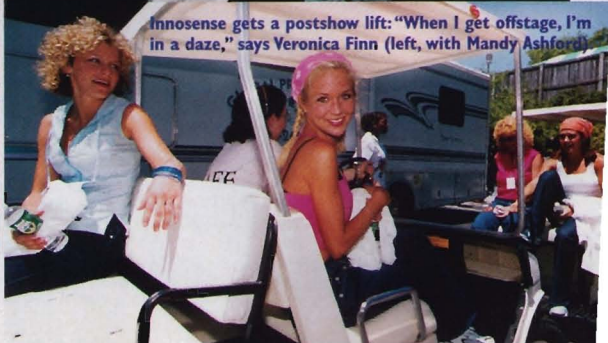

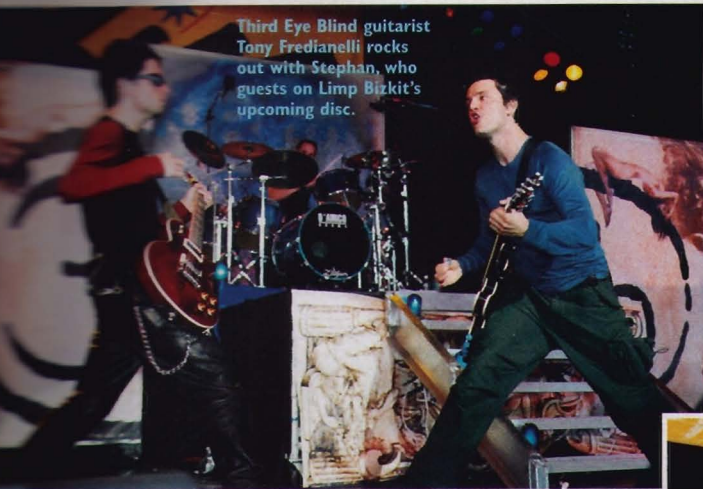

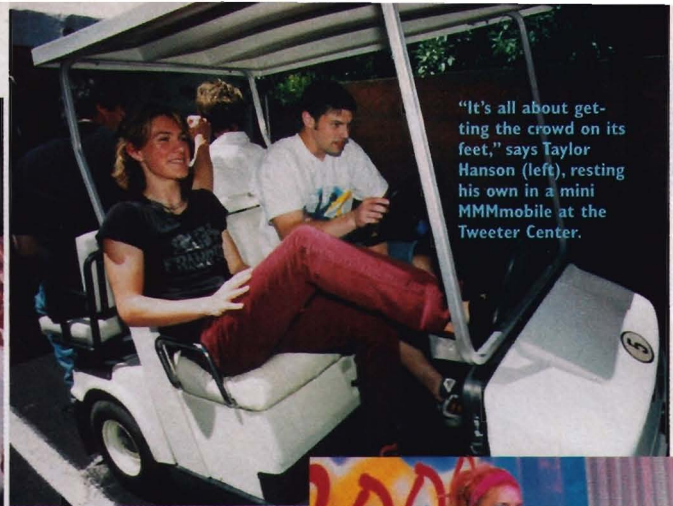

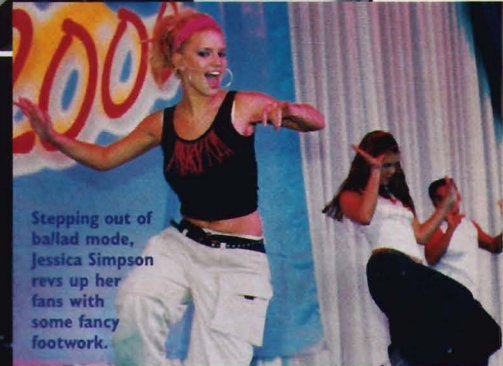

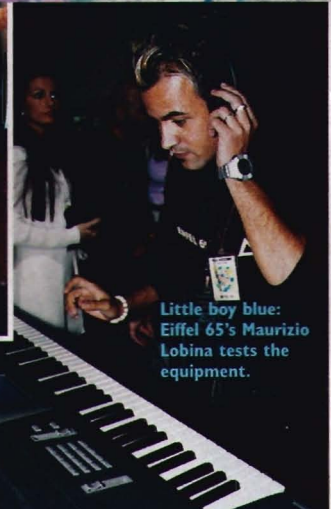

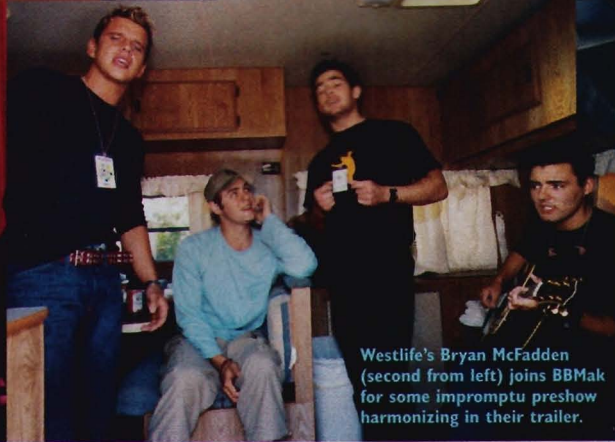

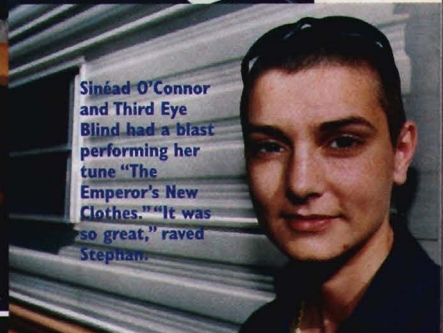

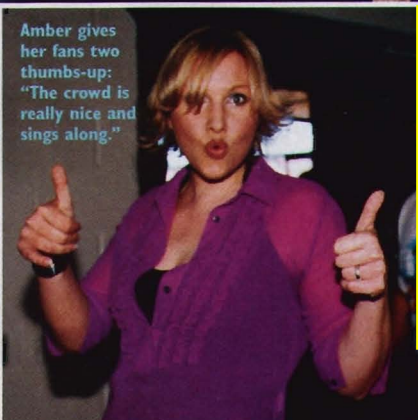

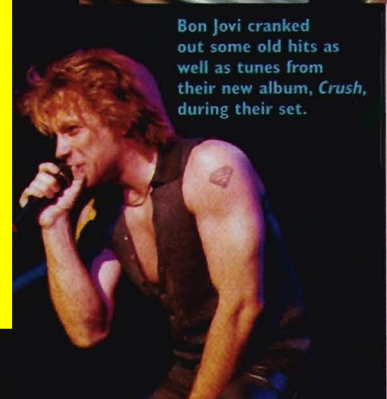
Sinead O'Connor and Third Eye Blind had a blast performing her tune "The Emperor's New Clothes." "It was so great," raved Stephan.
